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BEFORE THE DEPARTURE/RETURN OF THE BOAT

FORMALITIES AND BOARDING:

All the formalities and the boarding take place every departure day from 3 pm to 6 pm. There is no point in arriving before 3 pm because the registration and the boarding cannot start before this time, being the morning reserved for the return of our previous clients and the preparation of the boat for the following ones.

Early check-in: It is however possible to choose the early check-in formula, by agreement with the office personnel and according to the availability, at a cost of 80 € (from 11 am).

If you think you are going to arrive late instead, it's necessary that you ring the base to let us know. If we're aware, and you're only a little delayed, we will stay until you get there. If you're going to be very late, we will give you instructions about going on board, and we will do the check-in the following morning.

Do remember there may be several other boats starting on the same day as you, so please be patient and remember that the staff can't look after everybody at the same time. Relax on board and please wait your turn.

You should never expect to do any cruising on the first day; you will generally spend the first night at the base.

We suggest you empty your suitcases straight away and put them back in your car; otherwise they will take up valuable storage space on board. If you come by train or plane, ask the base to keep your suitcases until you return.

Before you unpack your belongings/luggage, check the inventory of your boat, the condition of the fenders and the safety equipment. Please notify us immediately if something is broken or missing. An employee do the following formalities (it will take between 30-45 minutes). Our base staff will be delighted to advise you about your cruising plans. A technician will explain you the engine and the boat's equipment... If you are unsure of anything, please ask for further explanation.

> INSURANCE & CAUTION:

- 1) **Insurance:** it covers damage to the boat, its equipment or caused to third parties by the use of the boat. The captain of the boat will contribute to the costs arising from any damage, up to the full amount of the security deposit. The insurance does not cover what is listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance".
- 2) **Damage deposit:** it is a guarantee of payment in favour of the captain for the sums due by

the driver in the event of a claim (damage, loss and damage to third parties) and in the cases listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance".

- 3) **Damage waiver (optional):** this insurance will reduce the sum of money to leave as damage deposit.
- 4) **Reduced deposit:** it is a guarantee of payment in favour of the captain for the sums due by the driver in the cases listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance". It will have to be paid both by those who choose the damage waiver and by those who choose the «All Inclusive Pack».
- 5) **Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance:**
 - The occupants of the boat and their civil liability; theft and damage to their property and valuables;
 - Damage to the boat, breakage or loss of on-board equipment due to negligence (ex. burning of the worktop, tearing of the curtains, loss of the gangplank or fenders, breakage of glasses and dishes, etc.);
 - Damage to the terrace, the flying bridge, the sun-deck and external accessories caused by strong wind or poorly aware navigation (against locks, bridges, etc.);
 - Towing, removal and detachment and damage to the hull in dry areas;
 - Damage to the propeller;
 - Maintenance operations due to incorrect use of on-board systems (ex. wc, bow thruster, etc.);
 - Penalties for fines. Deliberate violation of navigation regulations;
 - Abandonment of the boat during the cruise or delayed return of the boat to the base;
 - Pollution;
 - Misleading declaration.

> DIESEL FUEL ADVANCE:

At the start of your cruise, your diesel tank will be full. According to the type of boat, the tank gives a range of at least 40 engine hours.

At your departure, the base will ask for an «advance on fuel» which will be deducted at the end of your cruise.

The consumption is calculated according to the real number of hours you cruised, shown by the time meter in the boat and on the basis of the consumption as shown in the table below. If you stay longer, our team will tell you how to proceed.

You don't have to pay the advance if you take the «All-Inclusive Pack».

The 220V current generator, the heating and the production of hot water of certain boats is by

diesel. A separate time meter for the boiler will show how long it ran.
The lump sum prices can be modified at any moment, depending on the fuel price.

> PARKING:

It is about 800 m from the base (12,00 € / day). Please note that our bases do not accept responsibility for theft, loss or damage to your car while it is parked. Parking is always at the owner's risk. The fee charged is for parking your car and not for care taking. We do NOT accept responsibility for any injuries to people either. Do not forget to lock your car and to switch the radio and lights off.

> BED PREPARATION:

When you arrive you will find bed sheets and towels. You will have to take care of their arrangement, but if you prefer we can make your beds at a cost of 10,00 € per person.

> FINAL CLEANING:

The day of the return, you will have to give the boat back, cleaned inside as well as outside. If you do not wish to do it, you can choose the fixed cleaning service. This means the staff of the base will take charge of the cleaning.

Nevertheless, we will ask you, before returning the boat:

- To wash the dishes and store them,
- To throw the rubbish in the rubbish bins provided,
- To empty and arrange the closets and the drawers,
- To strip the beds.

We would have to charge for 2 cleaning services if you do not respect those instructions.

The cleaning service is included also in the «All-Inclusive Pack».

> PETS:

Dogs and other domestic animals are welcome on board. Verify that the animal is vaccinated and make sure you provide essential equipment for your animal; you will not find it neither on board nor at the base. Please ensure that your pet does not sleep on the bedding.

At your departure, you will have to pay for each animal: € 50,00. With a pet on board, the payment of the «final Cleaning» fee will also be mandatory.

> BICYCLES:

Bicycles are a great complement to a cruise. They allow you to move away from the river or canal, when you stop, so that you can discover the surrounding countryside. They are very useful to go shopping in the cities and towns nearby.

Bikes provided by us are folding and the hire costs 8,00 €/day/bicycle.

It is better to reserve your bicycles in advance. Of course we always try to provide the bikes ordered in advance, but cannot guarantee it.

Bicycles are not insured against theft, you are responsible for them.

Helmets aren't supplied.

> HIRING OF DINGHIES / BARBECUE / SUP / ELECTRIC SCOOTER:

The dinghy will be particularly appreciated by fishermen, ornithologists and nature-lovers. It will allow you to go in the most hidden corners or to land while your boat can remain at anchor in a well sheltered bay. In a dinghy/small boat, everybody must wear a life-jacket. Towing is prohibited. The cost is 15,00 €/day (min. one week).

The barbecue will allow you to cook delicious grills to enjoy with friends. The cost is 35,00 €/weekend or mini-week, 50,00 €/week and 7,00 €/day extra.

The sup will allow you to have more direct contact with the lagoon and an alternative to houseboat navigation, to discover the surrounding area. The cost is 120,00 €/week.

The electric scooter will allow you to move around in speed, an alternative to the classic bicycle. The cost is 18,00 €/day.

Attention, the number of these extras is limited. Book them at your departure base in advance!

> Wi-Fi:

Stay connected during your holiday! PC, tablets and smartphones always online!

It's possible to reserve a mobile Wi-Fi modem that travel at the speed of 4G to take with you during your cruise. The modem connects to the internet using 4G, 3G and 2G networks. You can connect to the device in USB or Wi-Fi, and it supports up to 10 simultaneous connections.

> CAR TRANSFER:

Car transfer from the base of Marano to Chioggia and vice versa: 150,00 €.

> ALL INCLUSIVE PACK:

On the departure day, at our base, it is possible to pay this service package, offered to a lower price. The «All-Inclusive Pack» includes: **damage waiver, consumables, final cleaning, a water map** and, on choice, a **parking for one car or one bike**. The «All-Inclusive Pack» must be paid at the base, on the day of departure.

Even with the choice of the «All-Inclusive Pack», a reduced deposit will required.

> METHODS OF PAYMENT:

You have the following methods of payment on site for the damage deposit and other extras: credit card Visa or MasterCard.

Of course you can also pay with cash (it's obligatory for the shopping basket service) but for security reasons, our base prefer cashless payment.

> RETURN OF THE BOAT:

The return of the boat is proceeded at 9 am. Please respect the time for the return of your boat, as the next customer is taking charge of the boat on the same day. We recommend to come back to the base the evening before.

Boat return formalities:

- Return your boat in a generally good condition (see «Final cleaning»)
- Return the extra hired or borrowed equipment (bicycles, etc.)
- Pay the diesel consumption (if you have not chosen the «All-Inclusive Pack»)
- The damage deposit will be withheld for maximum 21 days to cover possible damages and/or obligations towards a third party
- We remind you that you are responsible for the boat and its equipment in case of damages or accidents.
- Think about the following customers that will take your boat and report to the reception any kind of problems you have had.

If you choose to return the boat before scheduled time (e.g. for personal reasons) or if you want to pick up your car earlier, please inform the base in time. It's possible it is not open outside the departure days.

In case of a late return, the base may charge you with a half or a full day of your hire price.

The lessor reserves the right to recover from the hirer any expenses incurred as a result of an abandonment of the boat during the cruise.

SAFETY ON BOARD

Your boat is duly registered by an official insurance company as well as by the authorities.

It meets all the security conditions required by the law.

You have to contribute to the active safety of your boat and its crew:

- By taking the precaution of holding your children and your animals inside the boat while going through a lock or mooring.
- By wearing suitable shoes.
- By keeping minimum order on board.
- By taking care to roll up your ropes after each maneuver.

- By taking care while jumping off the boat.
- By explaining to the crew that they should never roll a mooring rope up around their wrist or ankles or try to stop the boat with their feet.
- By never keeping the boat hook in front of your body.

Attention! Never forget to hold the boat with one hand and keep the other one free to be used.

INVENTORY OF SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Extinguisher. Each boat is provided with extinguishers. Check where they are during your introduction to the boat in the base. If you have to use them during your cruise, please don't forget on your return to the base to let them know.
- Anchors. All our boats are equipped with an anchor which would be your safety aid in the event of a breakdown or of a wrong maneuver near a dam. Before throwing the anchors over board, first make sure that the rope or the chain is firmly attached to the boat. Let it unravel to the maximum (approx. 30 m).
- Lifebuoy and life-jackets. All our boats are supplied with a lifebuoy and sufficient life-jackets. If you travel with children, request life-jacket for their size before you leave the base (starting from 10 kg). Order matching life-jackets 10-15 days before your departure.

IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT

Please call the base immediately; our employees will help you and give you all the instructions and, if necessary, will send someone out to help you. In case of an accident with a third part, it is the captain's responsibility to fill in an accident statement (a specimen is in the board documents), not forgetting to note names and addresses of the witnesses.

Attention: Like on the road, never sign a declaration admitting your responsibility.

Take immediately a picture of the boat after the accident, in particular of the damage on both boats even the other one.

In case of doubt or of disagreement, it is better to wait for a member of our base or someone from the police. In a lock, you have the right to ask for a report on the accident to the lock keeper.

IN CASE OF A BREAKDOWN

Fortunately, breakdowns are rare but can happen. They can be of any nature: a problem with the engine, electric problems, problems with the heating.

If a breakdown occurs, call your base immediately (you will find the number in the boat users book).

Please be reminded that the breakdown service is included in the hire price and is at your disposal. Some problems can be solved directly by phone.

Please give the following information when you call:

- Your name and the name of your boat
- The precise location where you are
- The nature of the breakdown (according to your observations)
- A phone number, where you can be reached and the time of your call.

It is generally recommended to give your phone number on your arrival so that we can contact you in any case.

A technician will come as soon as possible, but give him some time to arrive. Do not try to fix the problem by yourself.

If the problem of your boat is not related to a purely technical reason, and you are able to sail, repairs will be done only in dry land (e.g. Fusina or Portograndi).

The presence of staff on the base of embarkation depends on the arrivals and the departures settled for that day.

For our boats the mooring and the services (water, electricity) in the base of Chioggia is free of charge.

HOW TO REACH CHIOGGIA:

Located at the south of Venice, on the coast, between sea and Lagoon.

- Chioggia-Venice: 53 Km
- Chioggia-Padua: 47 Km
- Chioggia-Udine: 170 Km
- Chioggia-Milan: 280 Km
- Chioggia-Trieste: 250 K



...By airplane.

Marco Polo Airport in Venice (about 60 Km from Chioggia) and Canova Airport in Treviso (about 80 Km from Chioggia) are the nearest airports to Chioggia.

- From the Marco Polo Airport to Venice (Piazzale Roma), get on the bus line ACTV n.5 AEROBUS (the bus stop is just outside the airport, service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: 20 minutes, ticket price: about 10,00 €). When you get in Venice – Piazzale Roma, catch the bus line ARRIVA VENETO nr. 80 (service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: 1 hour and 15 minutes, ticket price: about 6,90 €). Get off in Sottomarina (last stop). From the bus station to our base it takes about 5/10 minutes on foot.

Note: A direct bus service from Marco Polo Airport to Sottomarina is available with the bus line ARRIVA VENETO nr. 85. Check the timetables according to your departure time.

- From the Canova Airport in Treviso, take the shuttle ATVO «Airport Bus Express» (the bus stop is located just in front of the airport, service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: 1 hour and 10 minutes, ticket price: about 12,00 €) When you get in Venice-Piazzale Roma, catch the bus line ARRIVA VENETO nr. 80 (service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: 1 hour and 15 minutes, ticket price: about 6,90 €). Get off in Sottomarina (last stop). From the bus station to our base it takes about 5/10 minutes on foot.

- If you arrive from the Orio al Serio Airport in Bergamo, get on the ATB bus (service frequency: every hour, ticket price: about 5,00 €) that will take you in just 20 minutes to the Train Station of Bergamo. In Bergamo catch the train to Brescia and from there the one to Padua (total duration: about 2 hours and 20 minutes, ticket price: about 41,00 €).

In Padua get the bus “Chioggia/Sottomarina”, bus line FS-Busitalia nr. E005-V/E005-Z (The bus terminal is on the left at just 200 meters from the exit of the train station, service frequency every 30 minutes, duration: 1 hour and 20 minutes, ticket price: about 5,70 €). Get off in Sottomarina (last bus stop). From the bus station to our base it takes about 5/10 minutes on foot.

- If you arrive at the Marconi Airport in Bologna, get on the Aerobus shuttle – BLQ (service frequency: every 20 minutes, ticket price: about 4,00 €) that in just 20 minutes will take you to the Railway Station of Bologna. From Bologna catch the train to Rovigo and in Rovigo catch the regional train to Chioggia (total duration: about 2 hours and a half, ticket price: about 25,00 €), and get off at the last stop. Then from the railway station in 20 minutes you will get to our base walking across Chioggia (old town centre). As an alternative you can get the bus line ACTV n. 2 or n.6 (the bus stop is just at the exit of the railway station, service frequency: every 15 minutes, ticket price: about 1,30 €) that in 5 minutes will take you to Isola dell’Unione.

Note: Timetables and prices for bus and train services are indicative and can be subjected to changes.

As an alternative Rendez vous Fantasia can organize on your request a direct transfer from the airport of arrival to the base of embarkation.

....By train

- If you arrive from Milan or Verona, get off in Padua; then take the bus to “Chioggia/Sottomarina” line FS- Busitalia nr. E005-V or E005-Z, (the bus terminal is on the left just 200 meters far from the railway station, service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: about 1 hour and 20 minutes, ticket price: about 5,70 €). Get off in Sottomarina (last stop). From the bus station to our base it takes about 5/10 minutes on foot.

- If you arrive from Udine/Trieste get off at Venice Santa Lucia railway station. Go over the new bridge Calatrava and in a 5 minutes walk you will be in Piazzale Roma. Catch the bus line ARRIVA VENETO n. 80 (service frequency: every 30 minutes, duration: 1 hour and 15 minutes, ticket price: about 6,90 €). Get off in Sottomarina (last stop). From the bus station to our base it takes about 5/10 minutes on foot.

- If you arrive from Bologna get off in Rovigo railway station. Get on the regional train to Chioggia (duration: about 1 hour and 10 minutes, ticket price: about 6,00 €). From the railway station you can walk through the historical center of Chioggia and in 20 minutes you will reach our base. Otherwise you can take the bus line n.2 or n.6 ACTV (the bus stop is just outside the railway station, service frequency: every 15 minutes, ticket price: about 1,30 €). In 5 minutes it will take you to Isola dell’Unione.

Note: Timetables and prices for bus and train services are indicative and can be subjected to changes.

As an alternative Rendez vous Fantasia can organize on your request a direct transfer from the railway station of arrival to the base of embarkation.



....By car

Arriving from Milan or Verona (through the A4 motorway), follow in the direction of A13 Bologna – Padova, and drive for about 4 km. Take the motorway exit Padova Zona Industriale-Interporto, follow than in the direction of state road 309 “Romea” Chioggia- Ravenna for about 45 Km.



Arriving from Udine, follow in the direction of Venezia – airport, go on to Tangenziale di Mestre, then follow in direction of ultima uscita - Marghera - Ravenna and follow in the direction of Chioggia-Ravenna (state road nr. 309 “Romea”) for about 45 Km.

Arriving from Bologna, take the motorway exit A13 in Monselice, then follow in the direction of Chioggia-Sottomarina (regional road nr. 104 “Via Mare”) for about 40 Km.

Arriving from Ravenna, follow the state road nr. 309 “Romea”.

From all the above-mentioned destinations take the exit “Chioggia-Sottomarina” (1); keep your right side and go straight on about 1 Km in direction of “Sottomarina” and “Mare”, across the circle (take the second exit “Viale Mediterraneo”) (2).



Continue driving straight on for 1 Km along “Viale Mediterraneo”, across the 2 circles taking the second exit. Continue driving straight on for 500 meters, across the circle take the third exit “Lungomare Adriatico” (3). Continue driving straight on for about 2 Km and across the circle take the first exit. On your left side you will see the hotels Airone and Bristol (4).



Continue driving straight on and just after Hotel Ambasciatori, turn left. Leave on your left side the Monument to the Sailor man with fountain (**5a/5b**).



Continue driving straight on for 200 m., at the circle take the second exit and continue driving along via Veneto and via Roma (**6-7**).



In via Roma there is our office (**8**). To reach our base, go over the bridge (200 m.) and just before the circle on your right side, is our base, lying in the Lusenzo Lagoon (**9**).



If you have the GPS and you prefer to arrive straight to our office please digit:

Our base is 200 m further in direction of Chioggia, on your right side.



If you have the GPS and you prefer to, arrive straight to our base, please digit: PONTE TRANSLAGUNARE SOTTOMARINA; GPS coordinates: N 45°13'0.795"; E 12°17'0.941". These coordinates refer to the parking place in front of the base. You can park your car there and cross the street on foot at the roundabout. Some steps will take you to the lower sidewalk where our base is.

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT CHIOGGIA

SHOPS:

You can find all the shops you may need in Sottomarina and Chioggia. Opening hour is mostly from 09:00 till 12:30 and from 16:00 till 19:30, closed on Sundays. The market is held on Thursday morning in the historical center of Chioggia (Corso del Popolo).

For those who wish, it's possible require, at least 10 days before the arrival, to find on board a basket of essential items (see the form "**SHOPPING BASKET SERVICE**" herewith enclosed).

The weekly market takes place in Chioggia, along all of Corso del popolo, and is known in all of the Veneto area. It takes place every Thursday and in the dialect of Chioggia, it is known as: "el zioba". It is one of the biggest weekly markets in all of Veneto.

- Sardele in saore : fried sardines or anchovies preserved in a sauce of fried onions and vinegar.
- Moleche frite : crabs fried in plenty of oil in mute.
- Risi e vuovi : cuttlefish eggs boiled and seasoned with olive oil, vinegar and spices.

- Radicio de Ciosa : (typical local specialties chicory called "Rose of Chioggia") It can be served with oil and seasoned salt; roasted grilled; deep-fried cutlets.

- Bossolà : Typical specialties recognized as the "bread of Chioggia", fragrant and crisp, easy to maintain.

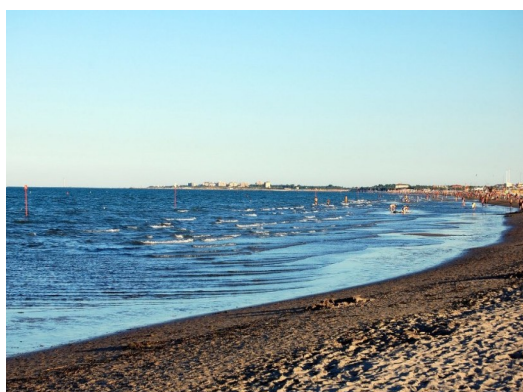
- Smegiassa : cake made with a mixture of black honey, flour, pumpkin, raisins, pine nuts and sugar.
- Sugoli : cream of black grapes and flour.

CURIOSITY:

Chioggia and Sottomarina. Two places linked by history and tradition. Sottomarina is an important bathing centre with modern and efficient accommodation. Chioggia is a town to visit in tranquillity and perhaps by bike.

Sottomarina is a stretch of land of almost 10 kilometres that fronts the Adriatic Sea. It continues beyond the mouth of the Brenta until the mouth of the Adige. It was once famous for its land suitable for growing vegetables.

It was an active and flourishing centre governed by a Tribune and fractions of the nearby Chioggia. Today the bathing resort is appreciated for its fine sandy beaches rich in minerals, such as clay, quartz, silica and micaceous elements, which make it suitable for sand-bathing and sun



treatments.

The wide bay is an ideal place to take long walks, while the modern bathing infrastructure allows thousands of tourists to spend their holiday in complete relaxation every year. There is a wide range of accommodation at Sottomarina, which offers hotels in all categories, campsites, and bed and breakfasts. There are also many opportunities to entertain oneself: amusement parks, volleyball and basketball courts, tennis courts, small piers for water sports, canoeing, hire centres for windsurfing, and even horse-riding. The nearby Chioggia, a town characterized by its herringbone urban planning, can be visited in tranquillity, perhaps by bike, as this is a place that holds many surprises. A small Venice with lanes and canals, palaces, churches, and monuments. Then there are the houses with their characteristic chimneys that recall the places in the comedies by Goldoni.



Chioggia is a city rich in history and tradition. Famous for its 'herringbone' urban shape and the bustling life in its "calli" and streets.

While the soul remains suspended between the land and the waters of the lagoon, Curzio Malaparte called it the "greatest café in Europe", referring to its lively and almost feverish life, so well described by Carlo Goldoni in his famous comedies. At almost all hours of the day it was crowded with people in the streets, calli, under the porticoes and above all in the countless cafés.

Today Chioggia, with its over 53,000 inhabitants, is the sixth most populous city in the Veneto, the second largest island in the Venetian lagoon, and has a 'herringbone' urban form.

It certainly existed in Roman times and perhaps owes its name to the Clodia trench, one of the branches of the delta of the ancient River Brenta. In 1110 it was a bishop's seat, and later subject to the authority of the Serenissima - Clugia Major (Chioggia) and Clugia Minor (Sottomarina) were the eleventh and twelfth islands of the Venetian doge. Famous in the Middle Ages for the production of the prized 'sal Clugiae', the city was the scene of the historic War of Chioggia (1379-80) between the Maritime Republics of Genoa and Venice.

A stroll through the city's 74 calli (narrow streets) immediately reveals that the beating heart is Corso del Popolo. This wide, 830-metre-long artery crosses the historic centre from north to south and is significantly called the 'piazza'. In fact, rather than a street, the Corso is more like a large and welcoming living room overlooked by the city's main monuments.

But the landscape is also made up of calli, bridges, porticoes, canals and squeri.

The calli are characteristic, not just simple streets but places where people live, work and play.

A common living room that extends living spaces that are always too cramped outside the home. And then there are the canals, which run through the city and divide the historic centre into slices: the Canal Vena, with its nine bridges, where the picturesque daily fish, fruit and vegetable market takes place; the Canal Lombardo and the Canal San Domenico, where the deep-sea fishing boats are moored.

The many porticos, which not even Venice (with the exception of St Mark's Square) has in such large numbers, are quite unique. A characteristic that - as the well-known art critic Cesare Brandi noted - makes Chioggia "half land and half water", "half Venetian and half Emilian". This is a solution for recovering living space, but it also provides shelter from the weather and the sun.

To complete the fishing landscape, there are the "squeri", shipyards where boats are built and repaired, with a particular architecture on the architrave of which a sort of small altar with a celestial image stands out, to protect the workers. A city that has all the ingredients for being simply unforgettable. An urban structure and architectural solutions that blend with the landscape, the scents and the colours.

Le TEGNUE of Chioggia. The Tegnue are, in Veneto dialect, those particular rocky substrata, typical in certain zones of watery depths, at the north of the Adriatic, well-known by local professional fishermen because they "hold back" and cut the drag nets which have the misfortune to land on them.

These formations normally reach some hundreds of meters squared of surface area, with forms and structures that are somewhat distinct and despite being isolated, they are not at all rare.

Even if they represent a minimal fraction of the surface of the sea bed, the Tegnue constitute an

important “oasis” for typical fish species of “hard” substrata, and increase the biological diversity, offering a greater number of ecological niches and constitute an excellent shelter for the reproductive phases of numerous marine organisms.

Their name is derived from the word in dialect which means “held”, which in local sailors’ jargon, has come to mean those underwater elements which present themselves as obstacles to fishing lines.

We are speaking of underwater depths with rocky formations, with an average depth between 19 and 22 meters. They are simply generic immersions, but at the same time they are fantastic for all to observe. In fact, the Tegnue represent the ideal habitat for the Conger, European Lobster, Corvine and a multitude of local fauna which in these areas are not disturbed by fishing lines. A unique Tegnua does not exist, rather tens and tens, all strongly characterized by type of seabed, depth, level and cracks which give refuge to passing fish, European Lobsters and coloured Spanish Dancer.
