Navigation information

Unauthorized mooring is prohibited on the Lot

When the flow of the river exceeds 170 m3 per second, navigation is stopped on certain parts of the Lot River.

The river is managed by a dam which makes navigation unreliable at certain periods in the year especially under heavy rainfalls

When navigation is impossible, we reserve the right to change your departure base elsewhere in France.

- Locks are manual: up to you to maneuver them: this allows you greater liberty, you can cruise from sunrise till sunset.
- These cruises are a bit more « athletic », so they are not recommended for a first navigation, nor for people having difficulty moving nor for people with small children.
- The first lock when you leave the base is at bit more than one hour. If the client arrives too late, departure will be on the following day.

Swimming is possible everywhere except near EDF structures and locks.

When passing through locks: lifejackets are compulsory for people taking part in maneuvers (even passive participation on the boat), animals in cabins and children with compulsory life jackets.

We do not manage the locks. In the event of a problem with the locks, a single number is noted on the lock explanation panel in an orange insert.
