BEFORE THE DEPARTURE/RETURN OF THE BOAT

FORMALITIES AND BOARDING:

All the formalities and the boarding take place every departure day from 3 pm to 6 pm. There is no point in arriving before 3 pm because the registration and the boarding cannot start before this time, the morning being reserved for the return of our previous clients and the preparation of the boat for the following ones.

Early check-in: It is however possible to choose the early check-in formula, by agreement with the office personnel and according to the availability, at a cost of 80 € (from 11 am).

Equally, if you think you are going to arrive late, it's necessary that you ring the base to let us know. If we're aware, and you're only a little delayed, we will stay until you get there. If you're going to be very late, we will give you instructions about going on board, and we will do the check-in the following morning.

Do remember there may be several other boats starting on the same day as you, so please be patient and remember that the staff can't look after everybody at the same time. Relax on board and please wait your turn.

You should never expect to do any cruising on the first day; you will generally spend the first night at the base.

We suggest you empty your suitcases straight away and put them back in your car; otherwise they will take up valuable storage space on board. If you come by train or plane, ask the base to keep your suitcases until you return.

Before you unpack your belongings/luggage, check the inventory of your boat, the condition of the fenders and the safety equipment. Please notify us immediately if something is broken or missing. An employee to do the following formalities (it will take between 30-45 minutes). Our base staff will be delighted to advise you about your cruising plans. A technician will explain you the engine and the boat's equipment... If you are unsure of anything, please ask for further explanation.

> INSURANCE & CAUTION:

- **Insurance**: it covers damage to the boat, its equipment or caused to third parties by the use of the boat. The captain of the boat will contribute to the costs arising from any damage, up to the full amount of the security deposit. The insurance does not cover what is listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance".
- **Damage deposit**: it is a guarantee of payment in favour of the captain for the sums due by

the driver in the event of a claim (damage, loss and damage to third parties) and in the cases listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance".

- **Damage waiver (optional):** this insurance will reduce the sum of money to leave as damage deposit.
- **Reduced deposit:** it is a guarantee of payment in favour of the captain for the sums due by the driver in the cases listed in point 5 of this paragraph "Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance". It will have to be paid both by those who choose the damage waiver and by those who choose the «All Inclusive Pack».
- **Exclusions from the guarantees of insurance:**
 - The occupants of the boat and their civil liability; theft and damage to their property and valuables;
 - Damage to the boat, breakage or loss of on-board equipment due to negligence (ex. burning of the worktop, tearing of the curtains, loss of the gangplank or fenders, breakage of glasses and dishes, etc.);
 - Damage to the terrace, the flying bridge, the sundeck and external accessories caused by strong wind or poorly aware navigation (against locks, bridges, etc.);
 - Towing, removal and detachment and damage to the hull in dry areas;
 - Damage to the propeller;
 - Maintenance operations due to incorrect use of on-board systems (ex. wc, bow thruster, etc.);
 - Penalties for fines. Deliberate violation of navigation regulations;
 - Abandonment of the boat during the cruise or delayed return of the boat to the base;
 - Pollution;
 - Misleading declaration.

> DIESEL FUEL ADVANCE:

At the start of your cruise, your diesel tank will be full. According to the type of boat, the tank gives a range of at least 40 engine hours.

At your departure, the base will ask for an «advance on fuel» which will be deducted at the end of your cruise.

The consumption is calculated according to the real number of hours you cruised, shown by the time meter in the boat and on the basis of the consumption as shown in the table below. If you stay longer, our team will tell you how to proceed.

You don't have to pay the advance if you take the «All Inclusive Pack».

The lump sum prices are all the base but can be modified at any moment, depending on the fuel price.

> PARKING:

- Free by the Marina PORTOMARAN.
- Guarded on request.

Please note that our bases do not accept responsibility for theft, loss or damage to your car while it

is parked. Parking is always at the owner's risk. The fee charged is for parking your car and not for care taking. We do NOT accept responsibility for any injuries to people either. Do not forget to lock your car and to switch the radio and lights off.

> FINAL CLEANING:

The day of the return, you will have to give the boat back, cleaned inside as well as outside. If you do not wish to do it, you can choose the fixed cleaning service. This means the staff of the base will take charge of the cleaning.

Nevertheless, we will ask you, before returning the boat:

- To wash the dishes and store them,
- To throw the rubbish in the rubbish bins provided,
- To empty and arrange the closets and the drawers,
- To strip the beds.

We would have to charge for 2 cleaning services if you do not respect those instructions.

The cleaning service is included in the «All Inclusive Pack».

> PETS:

Dogs and other domestic animals are welcome on board. Verify that the animal is vaccinated and make sure you provide essential equipment for your animal; you will not find it on board nor at the base. Please ensure that your pet does not sleep on the bedding.

At your departure, you will have to pay for each animal (€ 50,00/pet). With a pet on board, the payment of the "Final Cleaning" fee will also be mandatory.

> BICYCLES:

Bicycles are a great complement to a cruise. They allow you to move away from the river or canal, when you stop, so that you can discover the surrounding countryside. They are very useful to go shopping in the cities and towns nearby.

Bikes provided by us are folding and the hire costs 8,00 €/day/bicycle.

It is better to reserve your bicycles in advance. Of course we always try to provide the bikes ordered in advance, but cannot guarantee it.

Bicycles are not insured against theft, you are responsible for them.

Helmets aren't supplied.

> Wi-Fi:

Stay connected during your holiday! PC, tablets and smartphones always online!

It's possible to reserve a mobile Wi-Fi modem that travel at the speed of 4G to take with you during your cruise. The modem connects to the internet using 4G, 3G and 2G networks. You can connect to the device in USB or Wi-Fi, and it supports up to 10 simultaneous connections.

Car transfer from the base of Marano to Chioggia and vice versa: 150,00 €.

> ALL INCLUSIVE PACK:

On the departure day, at our base, it is possible to pay this service package, offered to a lower price. The All Inclusive Pack includes: **damage waiver, consumables, final cleaning**, one **water map** and, on choice, one **parking for one car** or one **bike**. The «All Inclusive Pack» must be paid at the base, on the day of departure. Even with the choice of the «All Inclusive Pack», a reduced deposit will be required.

> METHODS OF PAYMENT:

You have the following methods of payment on site for the damage deposit and other extras: credit card Visa or MasterCard.

Of course you can also pay with cash (it's obligatory for the shopping basket service) but for security reasons, our base prefer cashless payment.

> RETURN OF THE BOAT:

The return of the boat is proceeded between 8-9 am. Please respect the time for the return of your boat, as the next customer is taking charge of the boat on the same day. We recommend to come back to the base the evening before.

Boat return formalities:

- Return your boat in a generally good condition (see «Final Cleaning»).
- Return the extra hired or borrowed equipment (bicycles, etc.).
- Pay the diesel consumption (if you have not chosen the «All Inclusive Pack»)
- Your damage deposit will be withheld for maximum 21 days to cover possible damages and/or obligations towards a third party
- We remind you that you are responsible for the boat and its equipment in case of damages or accidents.
- Think about the following customers that will take your boat and report to the reception any kind of problems you have had.

If you choose to return the boat before scheduled time (e.g. for personal reasons) or if you want to pick up your car earlier, please inform the base in time. It's possible it is not open outside the departure days.

In case of a late return, the base may charge you with a half or a full day of your hire price.

The lessor reserves the right to recover from the hirer any expenses incurred as a result of an abandonment of the boat during the cruise.

SAFETY ON BOARD

Your boat is duly registered by an official insurance company as well as by the authorities. It meets all the security conditions required by the law.

You have to contribute to the active safety of your boat and its crew:

- By taking the precaution of holding your children and your animals inside the boat while going through a lock or mooring.
- By wearing suitable shoes.
- By keeping minimum order on board.
- By taking care to roll up your ropes after each maneuver.
- By taking care while jumping off the boat.
- By explaining to the crew that they should never roll a mooring rope up around their wrist or ankles or try to stop the boat with their feet.
- By never keeping the boat hook in front of your body.

Attention! Never forget to hold the boat with one hand and keep the other one free to be used.

INVENTORY OF SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Extinguisher. Each boat is provided with extinguishers. Check where they are during your introduction to the boat in the base. If you have to use them during your cruise, please don't forget on your return to the base to let them know.
- Anchors. All our boats are equipped with an anchor which would be your safety aid in the event of a breakdown or of a wrong maneuver near a dam. Before throwing the anchors over board, first make sure that the rope or the chain is firmly attached to the boat. Let it unravel to the maximum (approx. 30 m).
- Lifebuoy and life-jackets. All our boats are supplied with a lifebuoy and sufficient life-jackets. If you travel with children, request life-jacket for their size before you leave the base (starting from 15 kg). Order matching life-jackets 10-15 days before your departure.

IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT

Please call the base immediately; our employees will help you and give you all the instructions and, if necessary, will send someone out to help you. In case of an accident with a third part, it is the captain's responsibility to fill in an accident statement (a specimen is in the board documents), not forgetting to note names and addresses of the witnesses.

Attention: Like on the road, never sign a declaration admitting your responsibility.

Take immediately a picture of the boat after the accident, in particular of the damage on both boats even the other one.

In case of doubt or of disagreement, it is better to wait for a member of our base or someone from

the police. In a lock, you have the right to ask for a report on the accident to the lock keeper.

IN CASE OF A BREAKDOWN

Fortunately, breakdowns are rare but can happen. They can be of any nature: a problem with the engine, electric problems, problems with the heating.

If a breakdown occurs, call your base immediately (you will find the number in the boat users book).

Please be reminded that the breakdown service is included in the hire price and is at your disposal. Some problems can be solved directly by phone.

Please give the following information when you call:

- Your name and the name of your boat
- The precise location where you are
- The nature of the breakdown (according to your observations)
- A phone number, where you can be reached and the time of your call.

It is generally recommended to give your phone number on your arrival so that we can contact you in any case. A technician will come as soon as possible, but give him some time to arrive. Do not try to fix the problem by yourself. If the problem of your boat is not related to a purely technical reason, and you are able to sail, repairs will be done only in dry land (e.g. Fusina and Portograndi for the Venetian Lagoon itinerary).

- Marano-Trieste: 70 Km





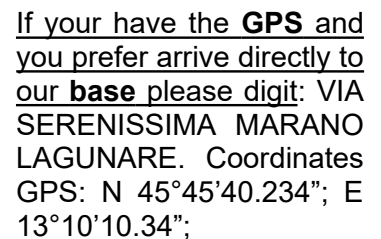
If you arrive at the international airport Marco Polo of Venice, the best solution is to take the taxi or the transfer which the company Rendez Vous fantasia organize by your request.

TYPICAL DISHES:

When talking about food and wine in Friuli Venezia Giulia special mention has to be made of San Daniele ham, famous and exported all over the world. The slightly smoked ham of Sauris is also well known. Their secret lies in the patient technique with which they are prepared (passed down from generation to generation) and the air of the places where they are seasoned, the charming hills of S. Daniele and the Alpine valley of Sauris. Other characteristic hams (with a more limited production) include those of the Carso plateau and Cormons.



Cheeses are very tasty. Supreme among them is Montasio, whose authenticity is guaranteed by an origin and quality label. Fresh and smoked ricotta as well as mountain cheeses, with different degrees of seasonings, are produced in Carnia, while the characteristic salty cheese is produced in the Arzino, Cosa and Tramonti valleys and Tabor on the Carso.

Among cold cuts, still produced by local butchers: salami, sopresse, sausages and musèt (often accompanied by brovada). Locally produced cakes include the gubana and strucoli of the Natisone valleys.

A vineyard called Friuli. This is a particularly suitable definition for the large variety and high quality of the regional wine production. There are no fewer than eight controlled origin denomination areas, which produce some excellent wines: Friuli-Aquileia, Carso, Collio, Colli Orientali del Friuli, Friuli Grave, Friuli Latisana, Friuli-Isonzo and Friuli Annia. Though different, all these areas are particularly suited to vine growing, a centuries-old tradition in Friuli Venezia Giulia, dating back to Roman times. Apart from the precious and rare Picolit, a famous "meditation wine",

sturdy red wines (Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Refosco dal peduncolo rosso, Terrano, Pinot nero, Schioppettino, ecc.) and aromatic white wines (Tocai friulano, Verduzzo friulano - Ramandolo is exceptional - Malvasia istriana, Chardonnay, Pinot bianco, Pinot grigio, Ribolla, Riesling, Sauvignon, Traminer aromatico, etc.) are perfect to accompany the tasty and refined dishes of local international cuisines.

Various spirits are renowned, first and foremost grappa (some top-quality single-grape ones), from the most traditional to those flavoured with herbs, berries and wild fruit.

CURIOSITY:

The Lagoon of Grado and Marano

The lagoon layout around Grado and Marano stretches out for about 16,000 hectares between the Isonzo Estuary and the Tagliamento Estuary; the whole system formed between 1400 and 1600, and it is protected from the sea by a dune reef which is more or less covered by a vegetation of trees, grass and bushes. The landscape always appears in different shapes and colours depending on each change in tide and it presents small islands, sandy reefs, submerged canals and waterbeds which come to the surface at low tide. By observing the vegetation from the river



banks, it is possible to recognise the famous tamarisks, trees with very thin branches, which were many a time mentioned by D'Annunzio, in their prevailing pinkish shades, and then elm-trees, poplar trees, pine-trees and junipers; as far as animals are concerned it is the birds that prevail: royal seagulls, sea swallows, white herons and cormorants. In order to visit the sandy islands that make up the lagoon and to admire the lidos and the water streams that make it up, it is advisable to schedule an excursion on a motorboat, from Grado

and Lignano. The lagoon around Grado represents the easternmost stretch of the whole lagoon system and it covers a surface area of almost 9,000 hectares from the Aussa estuary to the Isonzo River; it is subdivided into three sub-basins, corresponding to the lagoon harbours of Porto Buso, Grado-Morgo and Primero. This uncontaminated stretch is made up of canals and streams which intertwine between hillocks and small islands, to be explored on a boat or on a gommone on a

discovery trip of the characteristic “casoni”, but also on a mountain bike along the paths that skirt the fishing areas. The fishing wealth of the lagoon of Grado is thanks to the shallow waters and to the favourable environmental conditions, which allow various species of vegetation, fish and water birds to find their natural and ideal habitat.

Inhabited since ancient times, as findings dating back to the Roman Age show, the lagoon of Marano is a basin of soil impregnated with salt water situated between the Lowlands of Friuli and the Adriatic Sea, which formed as a consequence of a slow but steady and continuous rising of the sea level and of the abundant deposits of soil coming from the rivers.

The landscape of the surrounding areas is characterised by marshland vegetation: elm trees, pine trees, lime-trees, plane-trees and beech trees; the animal world is plentiful in even rare species such as the red heron, which in these areas find a possibility of refuge, food and reproduction. The lagoon of Marano includes two sub-basins: Lignano and S. Andrea, both corresponding to the lagoon openings; the arch of small islands and sandy reefs are crossed by a network of very many canals.

..... The Grado and Marano Lagoon

Friuli, a land of hospitality, good humour and good wine. The boat trip takes you through typical casoni (fish farms) and fish breeding marshes (fishing valleys), through sandbanks and small coastal strips, from island to island, from village to village, discovering ancient settlements and unusual flavours.

3-day cruise → Marano Lagunare, Aquileia, Grado, Preconico and Marano Lagunare. (Km 91, 13 navigations hours)

7-day cruise → Marano Lagunare, Aquileia, Grado, Lignano Sabbiadoro, Preconico and Marano Lagunare (Km 109, 16 navigations hours)

..... The Venetian Coast

It is an ancient waterway, created by “Serenissima” during the period of maximum splendor.

It is a classical navigation route, one which offers a varied and surprising scenery: From the fishing cottages to the Grand Canal palaces, from the wide estuaries of the Venetian rivers to the green landscape cut from the beds of reeds, from a productive countryside to lazy beaches.

7-day (one way cruise) → Chioggia, Venice and other islands of the Lagoon, Jesolo, Musile di Piave, Cortellazzo, Caorle, Bibione, Lignano Sabbiadoro, Grado, Aquileia, Marano Lagunare or the other way around. (Km 238, 5 locks, 6 swing bridges, 34 engine hours)

11-day cruise → Chioggia, Venice, Jesolo, Caorle, Bibione, Lignano Sabbiadoro, Grado, Marano, Porto Santa Margherita, Portograndi, the islands of the Lagoon and Chioggia. (Km 371, 10 locks, 11 swing bridges, 53 engine hours)
